The boys varsity basketball team won the B-K-W Holiday Tournament defeating Class B Tamarac 100-68, including a school record 16 3's in the opening round and defeating B-K-W 66-64 in the Championship. Cole Ackerman was named tournament MVP and Damien Fiducia to the All-tournament Team.

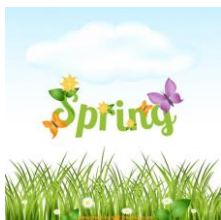
