Greenville High School is happy to announce the opportunity for students to participate in the emerging world of virtual learning. This Virtual Learning Academy is designed for students who would like to take a course they have never taken before in our high school. Students will be able to register for a variety of online courses. Our high school courses are offered in cooperation with Questar III and Aventa online learning.

These courses enable our students to purchase college credit while at the same time obtaining high school credit. Our college courses are offered in cooperation with Columbia Greene and Hudson Valley Community Colleges.

### **High School Credit Bearing Courses**

These classes are offered by Questar III utilizing Aventa Learning. These high school courses are \$250 per class and the registration forms are available in the High School Guidance office. Students wishing to enroll in these courses should speak with their Guidance Counselors regarding any August Regents exams that may be associated with this coursework. ### **Hudson Valley Community College**

High school students can now register for college-level courses offered at [Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk High School](#) this summer. HVCC College in the High School courses cost \$45 per credit hour and are taught by college faculty or high school teachers who are Hudson Valley adjunct faculty. Students can earn Hudson Valley credit for the courses which are transferable to most four-year colleges and universities. Transportation will be provided by the Greene County Business Alliance for Greene County students. Students can take a bus from the Greenville Central School District if they cannot transport themselves to Ravena. Courses offered at Ravena Coeymans Selkirk High School this summer are:

Classes run for six weeks, from **Tuesday, July 5 through Friday, August 12**. Classes will run five days a week except for Creative Writing: Short Fiction, which will run three days a week. **The deadline to register and pay for courses is Friday, June 24**.
