RE: Transportation

The purpose of this memo is to clarify transportation to and from your child's respective program. Transportation to all programs (Career and Technical, Tech Valley and New Visions) follows the Greenville Central School District calendar. When the district is closed, no transportation will be provided for any programs.

Tech Valley / New Visions: SUNY East & Sage

- At 6:30 a.m. the morning Tech Valley/New Visions bus leaves Greenville HS to drop off at Coxsackie HS by 6:40 a.m. to meet the shuttle bus
- Half-day students: At 12:15 p.m. we meet the shuttle bus at Coxsackie Transport to return to Greenville HS
- All day students: at 3:30 p.m. we meet the shuttle bus at Coxsackie Transport to return students to their home
- If your student needs transportation from your home to meet the 6:30 a.m. Tech Valley/New Visions run, please call the Transportation Department – 966-5070 ext 463
- When the Greenville Central School District has a two hour delay, transportation will not be provided to the Tech Valley and New Visions transfer point
- When the Greenville Central School District has ½ days scheduled, transportation will be provided for Tech Valley and New Visions students

CTE / Questar III / New Vision: Hudson

- The morning program runs from 8:15 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. and the afternoon program runs from 11:15 a.m. to 1:45 p.m.
- At 7:20 a.m. the morning bus leaves the HS to the morning programs in Hudson and returns around 11:30
- At 10:30 a.m. the afternoon bus leaves the HS to the afternoon programs in Hudson. Your child will be transported back to Greenville to board the regular bus home. Students will be enrolled in classes' periods 1-3 at Greenville HS
- If your student needs transportation from your home to meet the 7:05 a.m. morning bus, please call the Transportation Department – 966-5070 ext 463
- When the Greenville Central School District has a two hour delay, transportation will not be provided to the morning Career and Technical program at Hudson
- When the Greenville Central School District has ½ days scheduled, transportation will only be provided for the morning Career and Technical program at Hudson.

Based on the transportation requests, routes will be planned and you will be notified with the time of pick up for your student. We hope by this memo, this answers any questions you may have in regard to transportation for programs held outside the Greenville campus.
